Our Impact is What Matters

Playworks' vision is that one day every child in America will get to play -- every day. For almost 20 years, we have leveraged the power of play to transform children's physical and emotional health.

Our work is to create a place for every kid on the playground to feel included, be active, and build valuable social and emotional skills. We partner with schools, districts, and after-school programs to provide a service or mix of services including on-site coaches, professional training for school staff who support recess, and consultative partnerships. Together with dedicated principals, district administrators, parents, and teachers we are building a movement for play.

Values such as respect, inclusion, healthy play, and healthy community are the backbone of this movement.

But it's not enough to describe our work. We are committed to running an efficient, high-performance nonprofit organization focused on impact. We measure our success in decreased disciplinary incidents, improvement in academic success, improvement in school culture, and the recovery of precious teaching time. And we've seen results. It can be seen in the lives of more than a half million students attending 900 schools in 23 U.S. cities who now have access to safe, fun, and healthy play.



2013-2014 Playworks Sources and Use of Funds

Playworks uses a diversified funding model to support its sustainability. School fees, training fees, and government grants together account for approximately 40 percent of Playworks' revenue, creating a stable, ongoing funding base. The remainder of the funding comes from a combination of foundation, corporate and individual supporters. Playworks had total net assets of \$5.9 million as of June 30, 2014.
